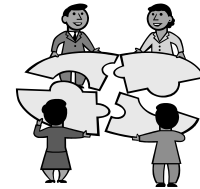
Donations & Memorial Gifts

Severe Weather



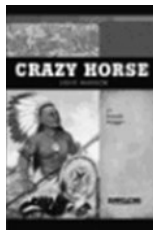
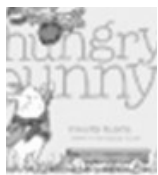
Please note the library will close early or be closed when there is severe weather, such as snow or ice. If you are unsure, please call before coming to the library.
